



Jonah was feeling grumpy.

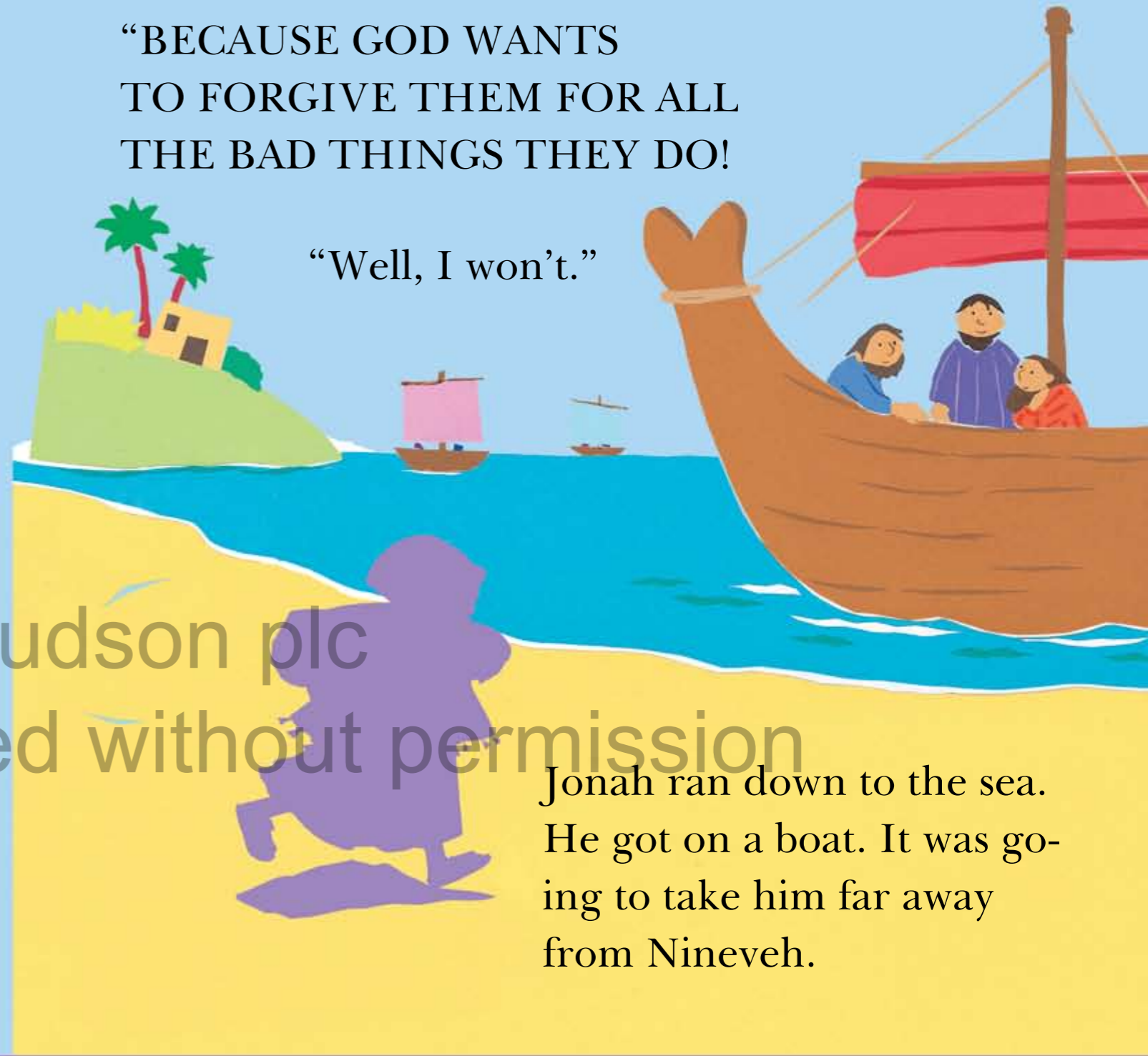
“I’m a prophet,”

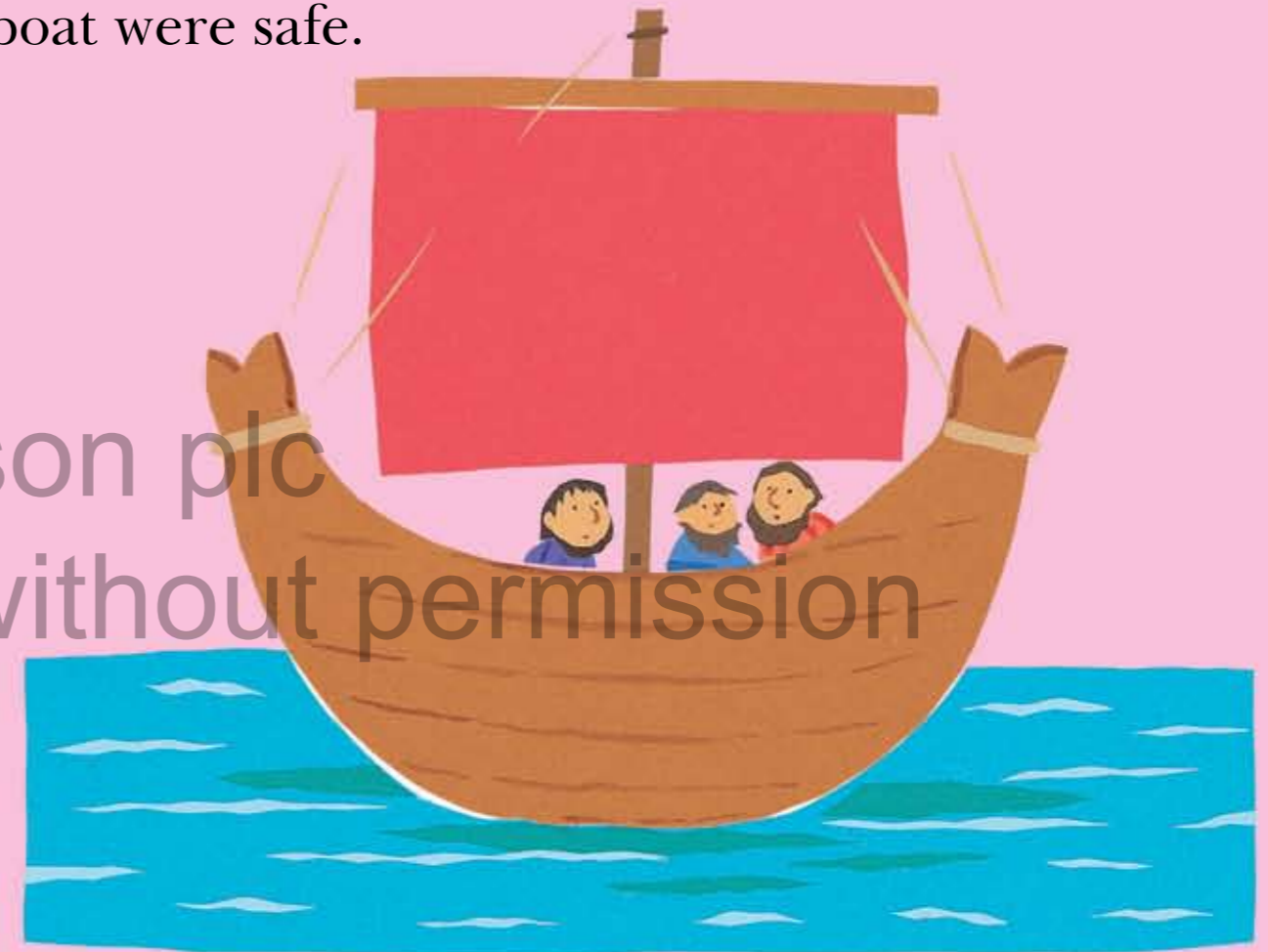
Now find a sticker for the
