- **Colossians 3:3** I am kept safe with Christ in God.
- **1 John 5:18** I am a child of God and I am safe from any evil.

I am no longer rejected, unloved or dirty. In Christ I am completely accepted. God says:

- John 1:12 | am God's child.
- John 15:15 | am Jesus' chosen friend
- Ephesians 1:1 | am a saint, a holy person.
- **Colossians 1:14** I have been forgiven for all the things I've done wrong.
